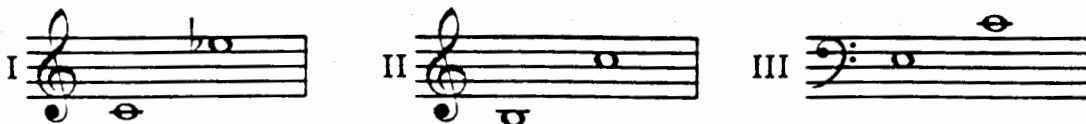


AGNUS DEI

The text of Agnus Dei dates from the early Christian church, and it became an integral part of the Mass by the eleventh century. Historically, the Mass has been divided into two sections: those with texts appropriate for a specific feast (the Proper), and those which could be used at any time (the Ordinary) of which Agnus Dei is a part.

A translation and an approximate phonetic pronunciation of the Latin text is as follows:

Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi,  
miserere nobis. (repeat)  
Agnus Dei, qui tollis peccata mundi,  
dona nobis pacem.

Lamb of God, who takest away  
the sins of the world,  
have mercy on us. (repeat)

Lamb of God, who takest away

grant us peace.

This piece should be performed very legato with very little vibrato, giving careful attention to the natural rise and fall of the independent phrases, as well as to the purity of vowels and tone.
